

THE WORD THIS WEEK

FOURTH SUNDAY OF SUNDAY OF EASTER

This Sunday is traditionally called 'Good Shepherd Sunday', because of the Gospel references to Jesus as the Good Shepherd. It is also the day of prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood. On this Sunday we hear one of the great 'I am' statements of Jesus from Saint John's Gospel today 'I am the gate of the sheepfold'.

Through Jesus we enter into life and safety, and we 'go through Jesus, the gate' by baptism. This image is implied in all today's readings: the people listening to Peter find this gateway and enter through it: Peter writes to remind us that we have come back to the Good Shepherd, who heals us by his wounds.

First: Acts 2:14, 36-41 - Peter preached: God made this Jesus who you crucified both Lord and King - what must we do? -You must repent and be baptised in Jesus's name ... that very day, about three thousand were added to their number.

Psalm: 23 - The Lord is my shepherd / he guides me along the right path / You have prepared a banquet for me / Surely goodness and kindness.

Second: I Peter 2:20-25 - Merit in the sight of God is bearing punishment patiently ... now you have come back to the shepherd and guardian of your souls.

Gospel: John 10: 1-10 - Jesus said "I am the gate of the sheepfold, anyone who enters through me will be safe ... I have come so that they may have life and have it to the full.

3. HOPE IN THE FUTURE PRAYER CYCLE: Let us pray for the people of the parish of St. Clare, Blackley, and for Fr. Jeremiah and Fr. Colin, the Franciscan friars there. 
