## ST JOHN CHRYSOSTOM - 13 September 2023:

John Chrysostom 'golden mouthed' was born in Antioch in 349. He became Bishop of Constantinople in 397 but, because of his steadfast preaching, he faced opposition from the Empress. He died in exile in 407.

**SAINT CORNELIUS AND CYPRIAN – 16 September:** both lived in a time of turbulence in the Church: they were

at the forefront of the debate on reconciling those who had denied the faith under persecution. Together they struck a middle course and guided the Church onward by writing and preaching. Cornelius died in exile in 253; Cyprian was
